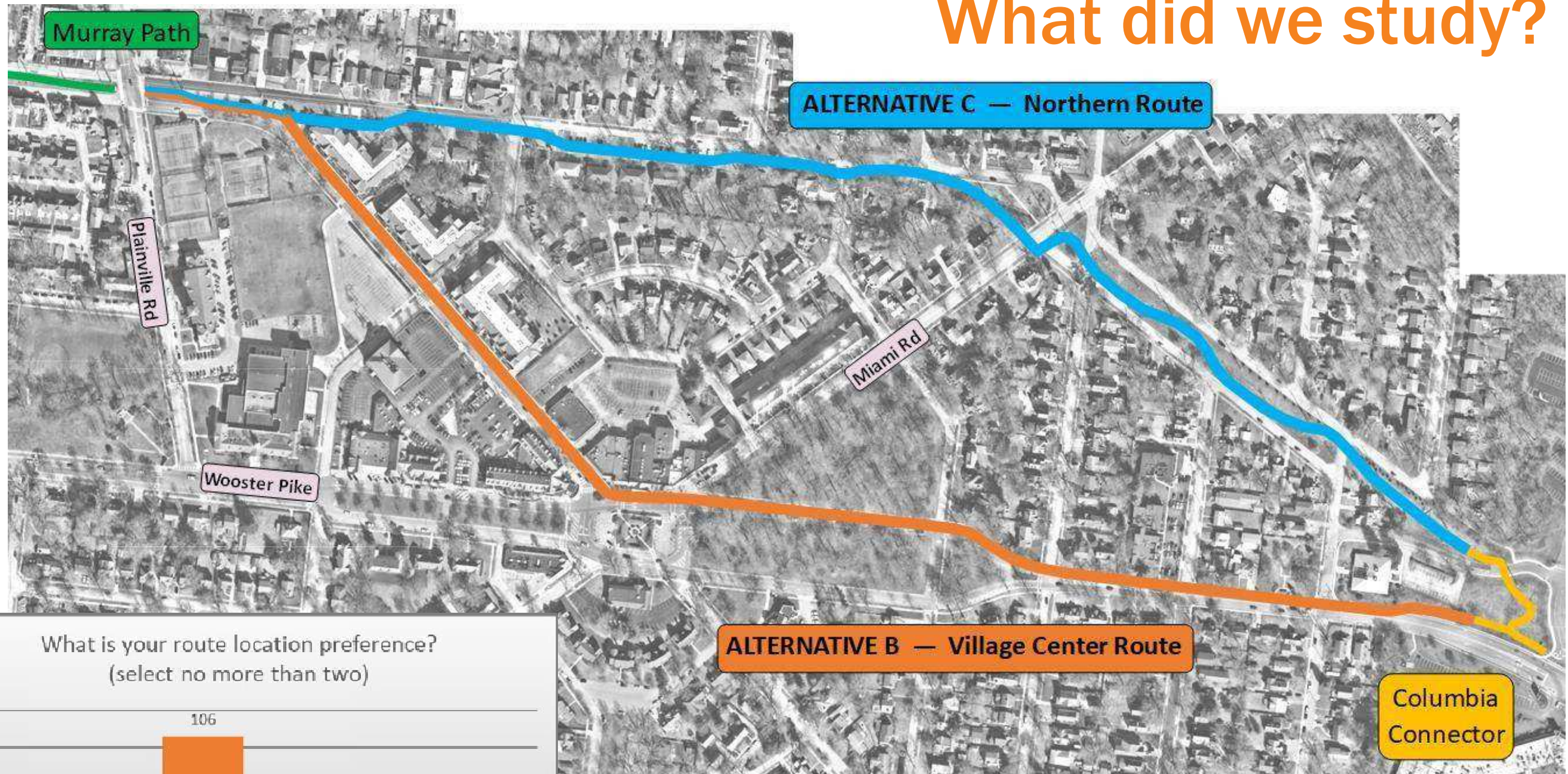

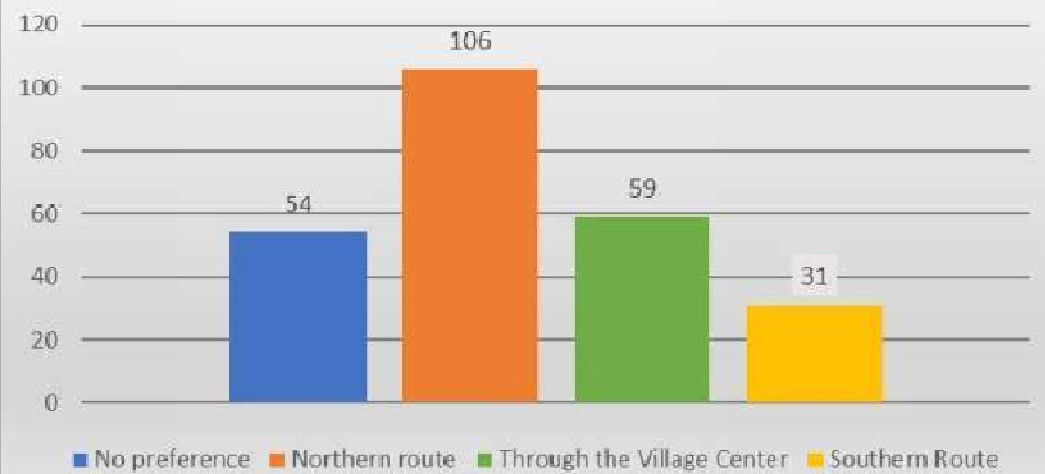

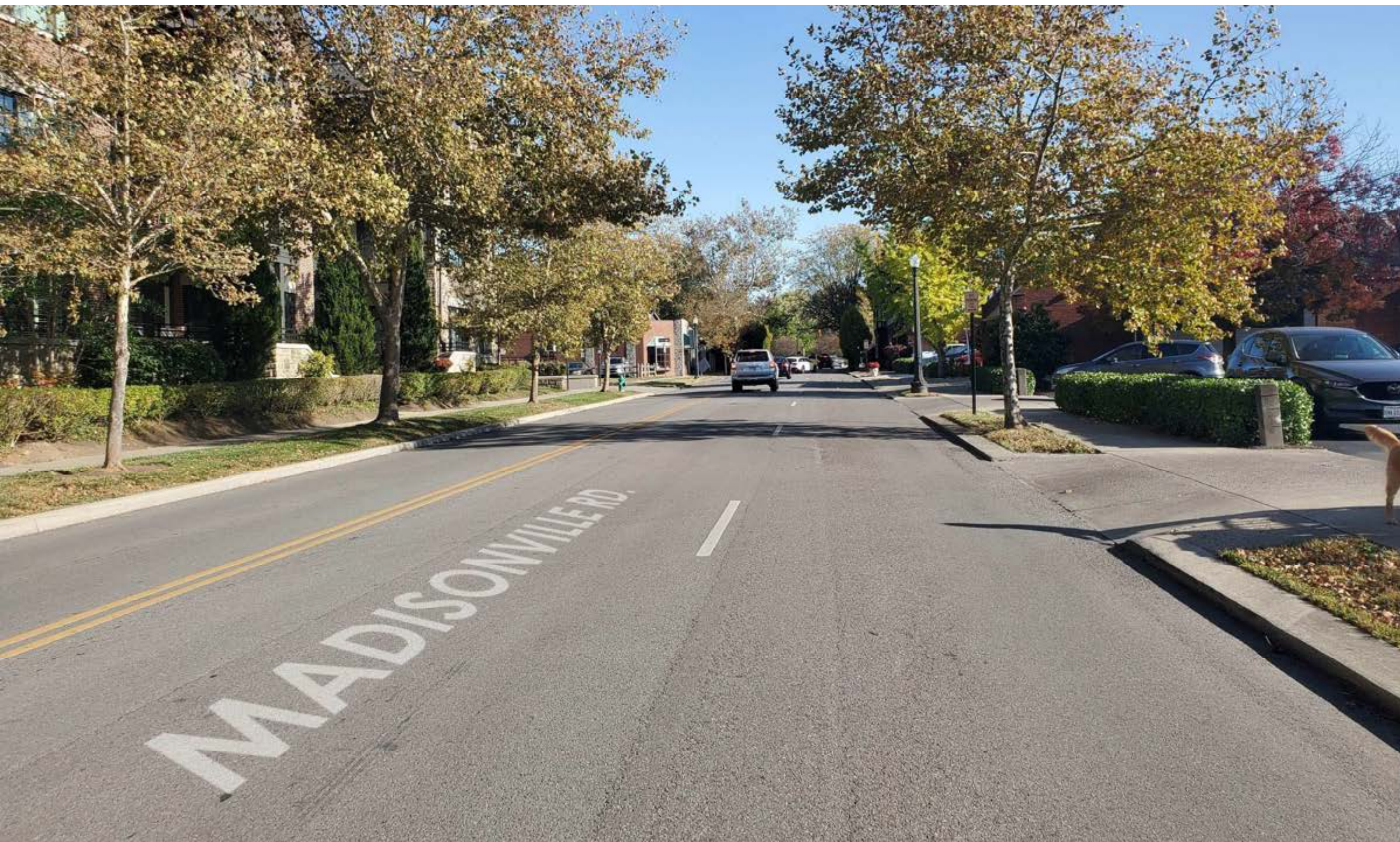

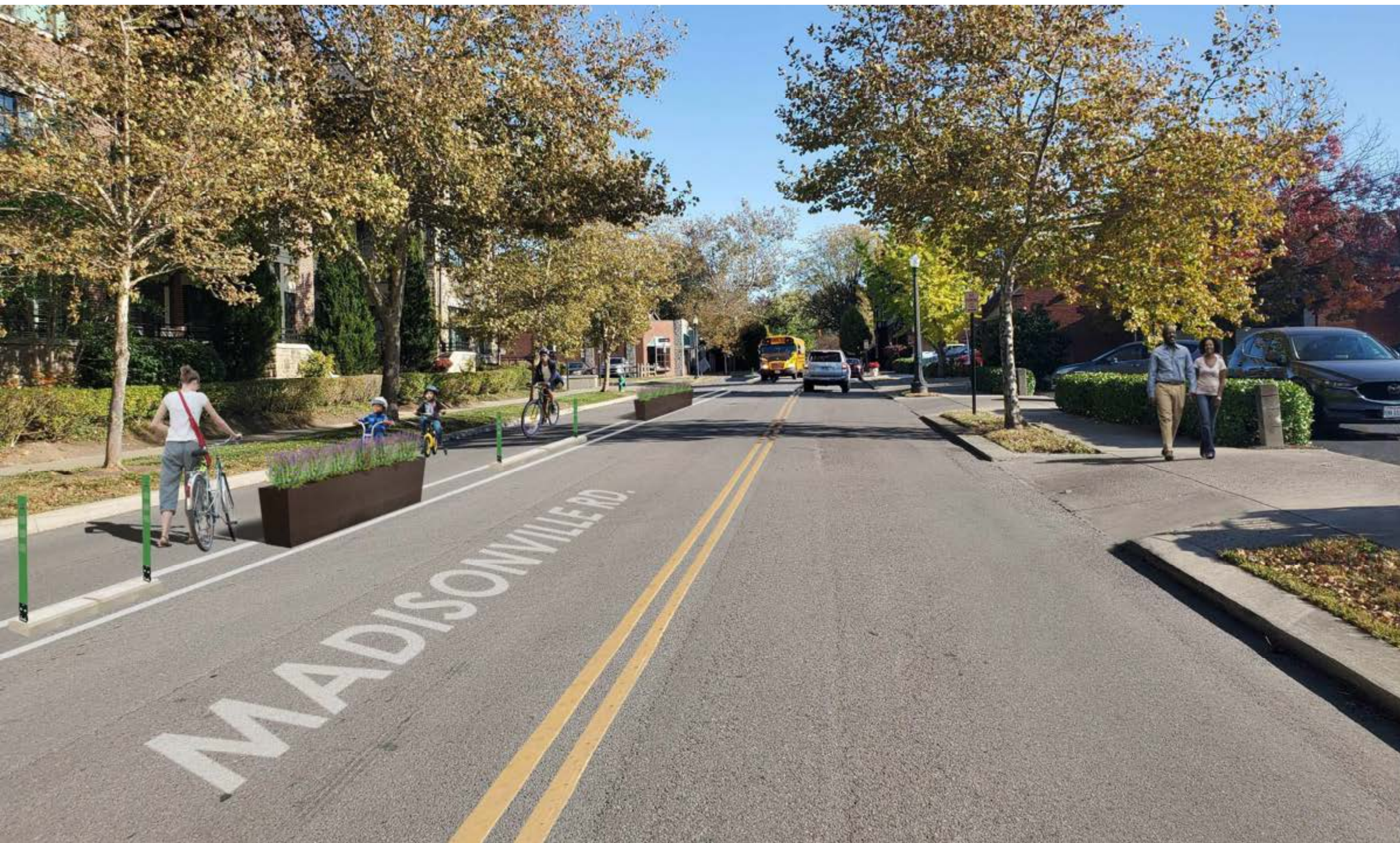

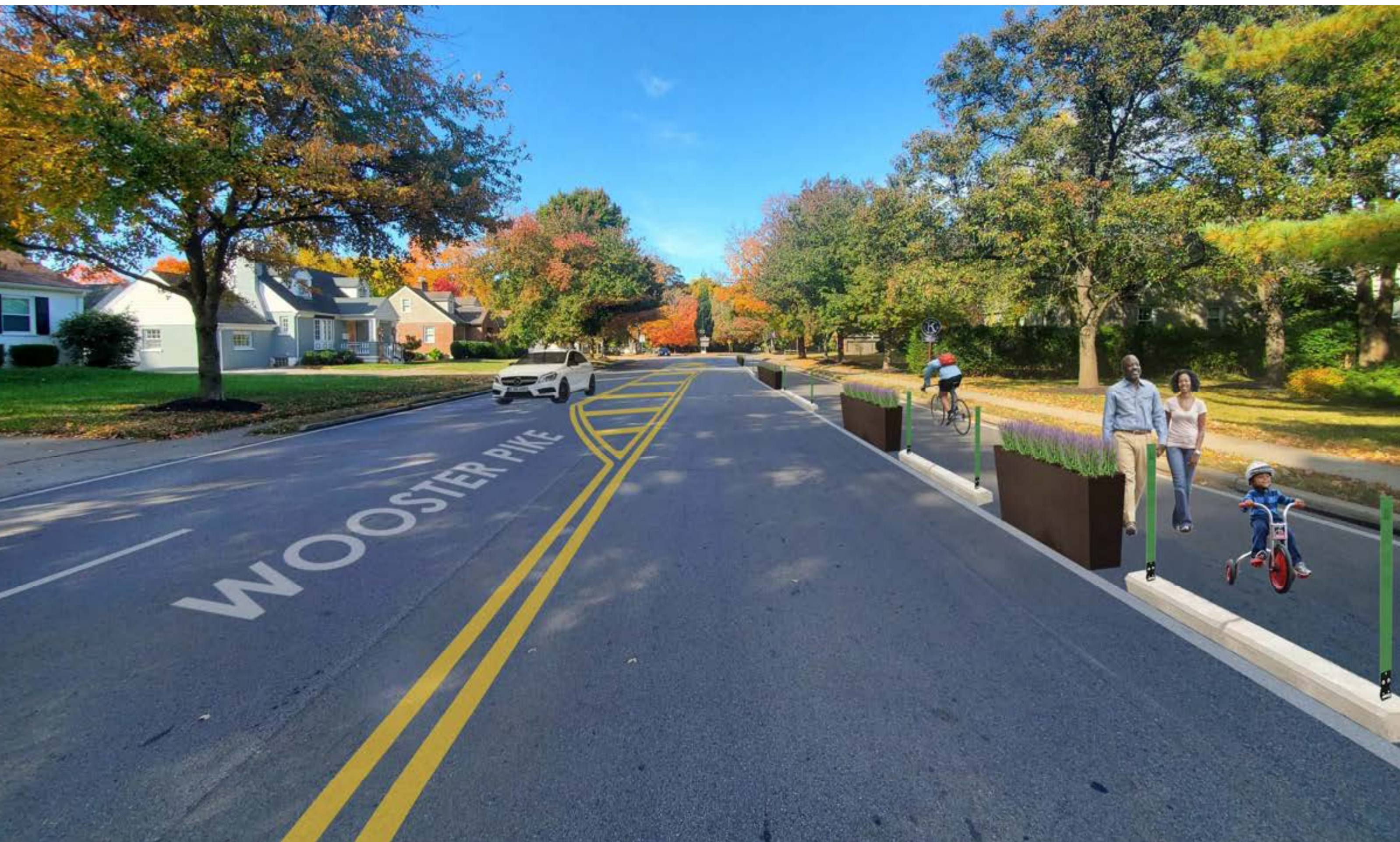

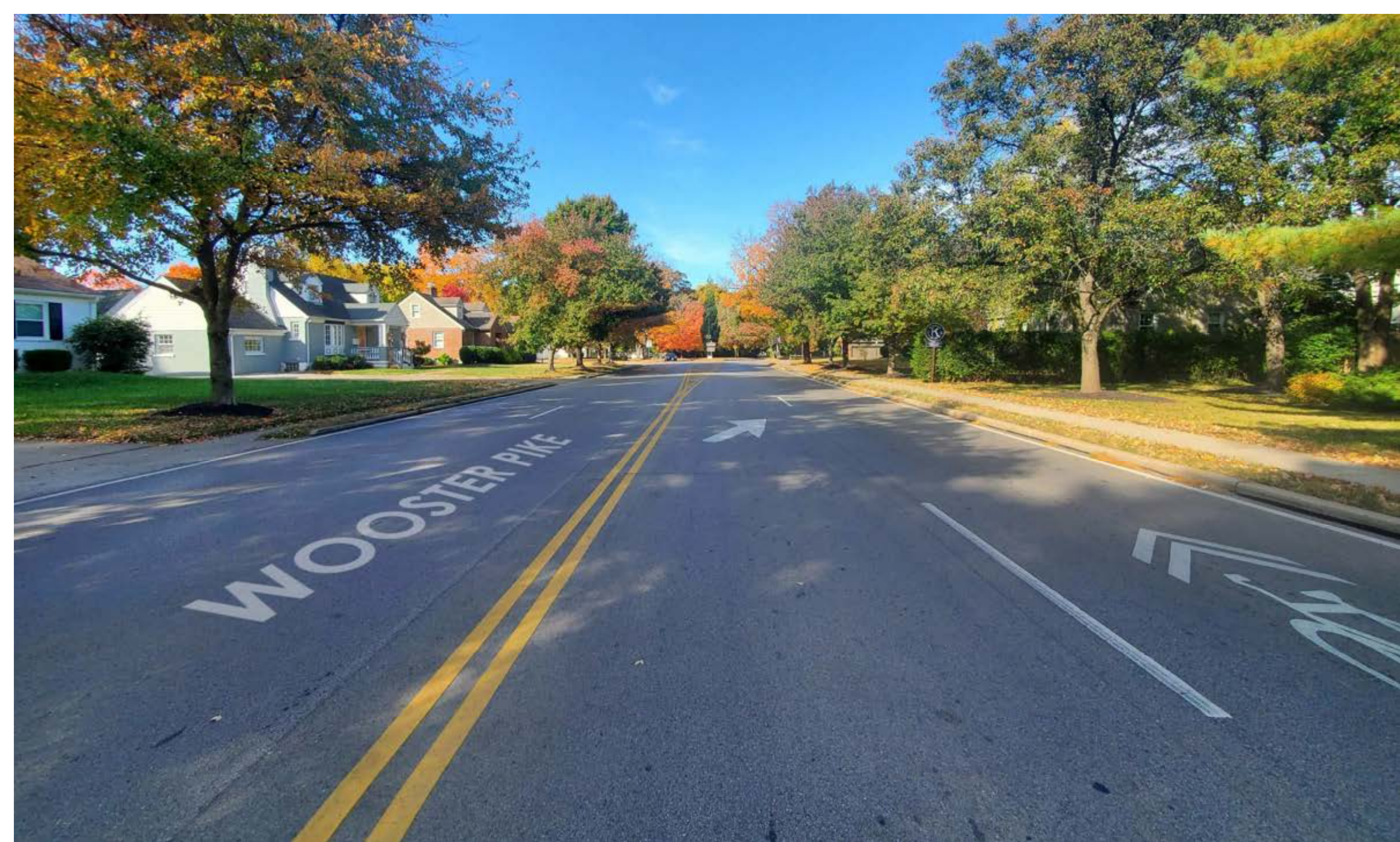






WOOSTER PIKE - PROPOSED DESIGN

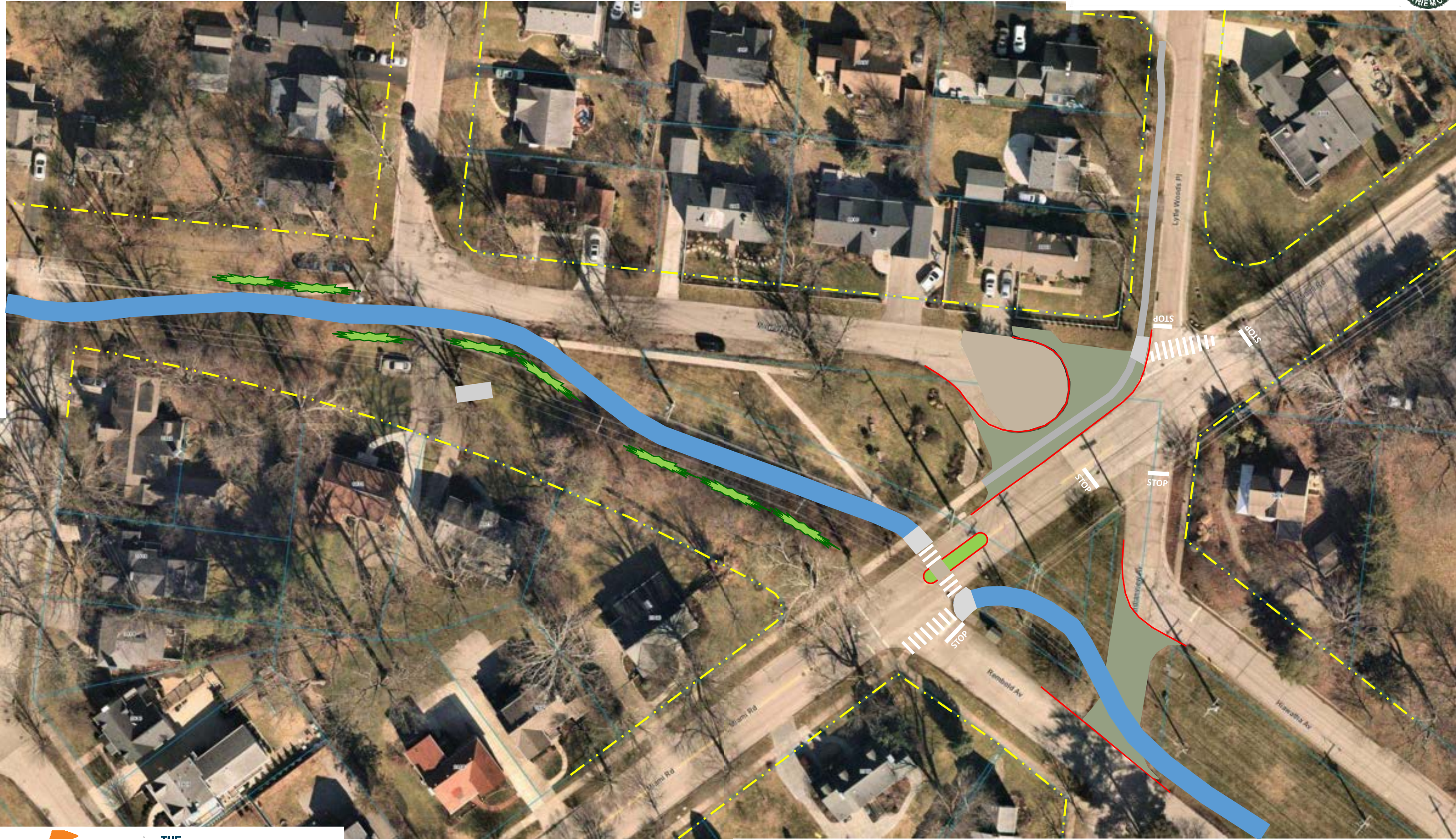

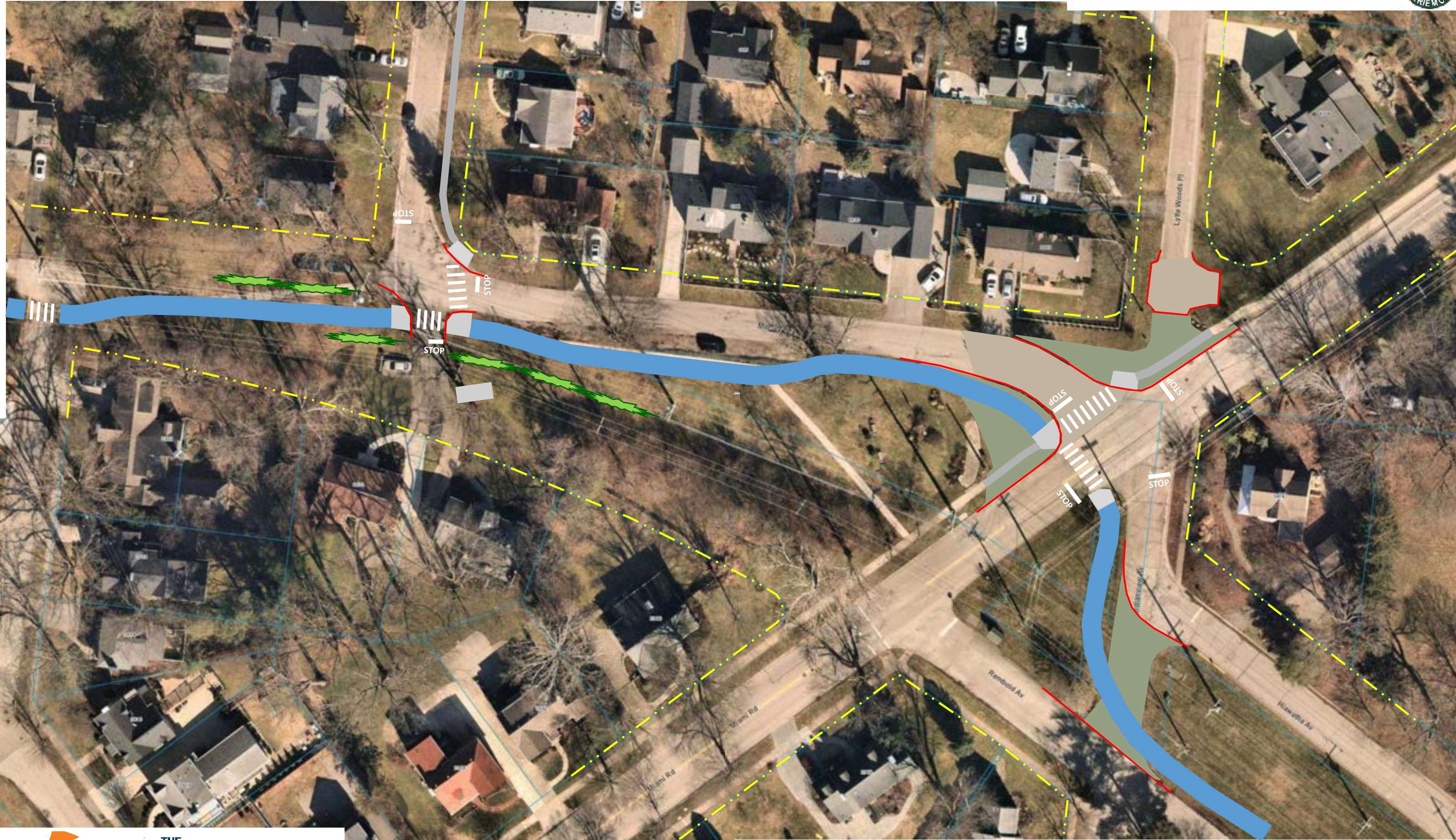


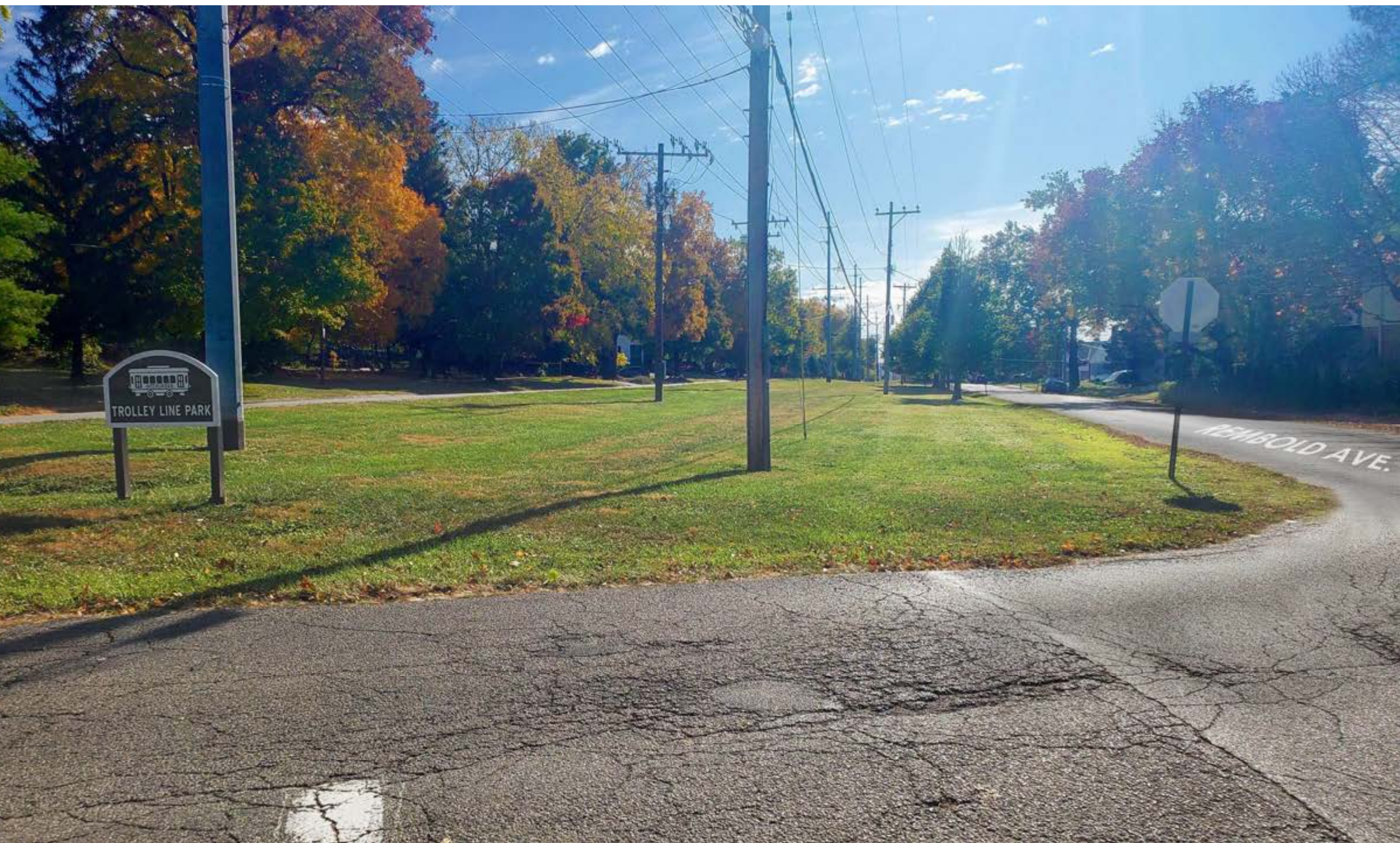
MURRAY AVE. - PROPOSED DESIGN

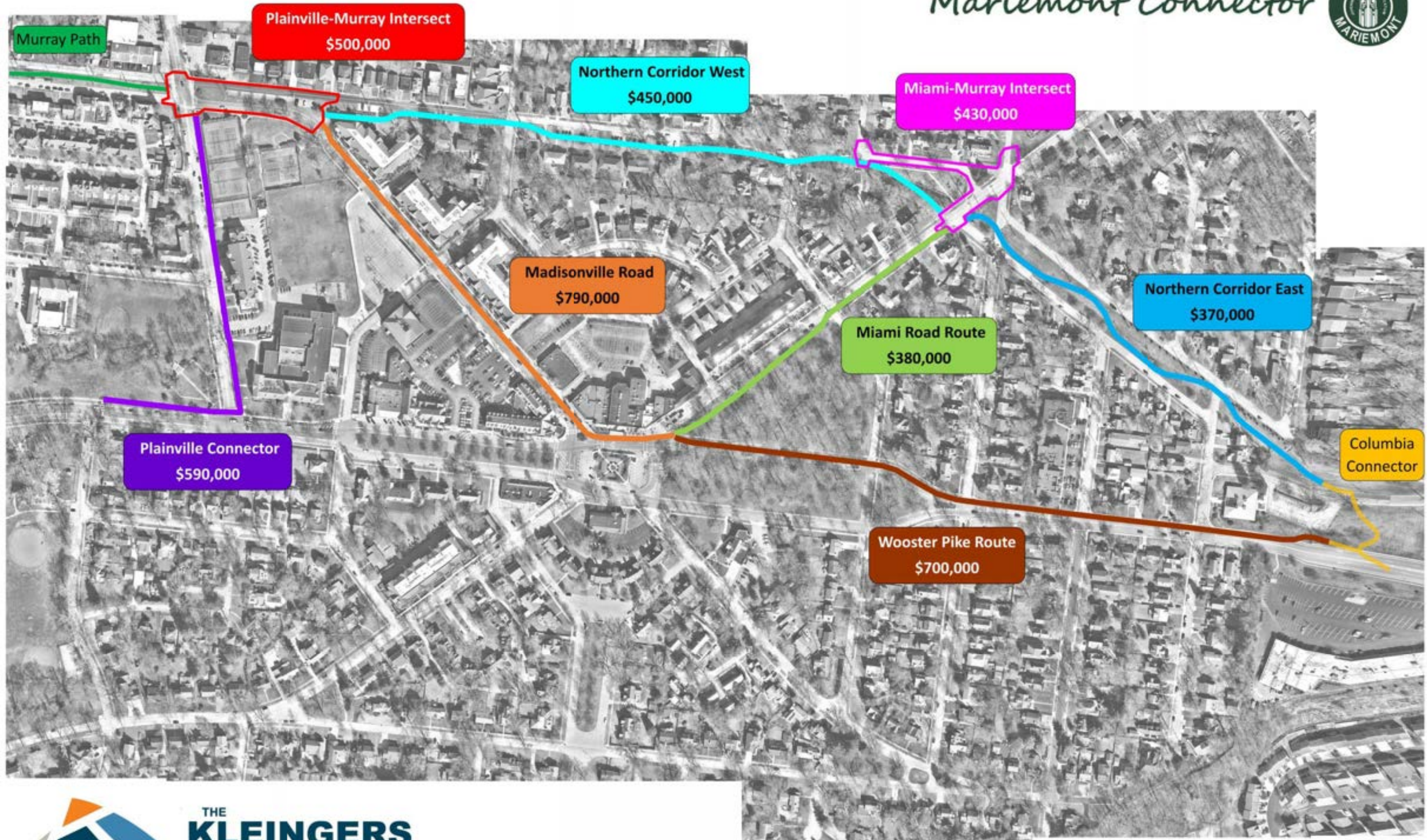

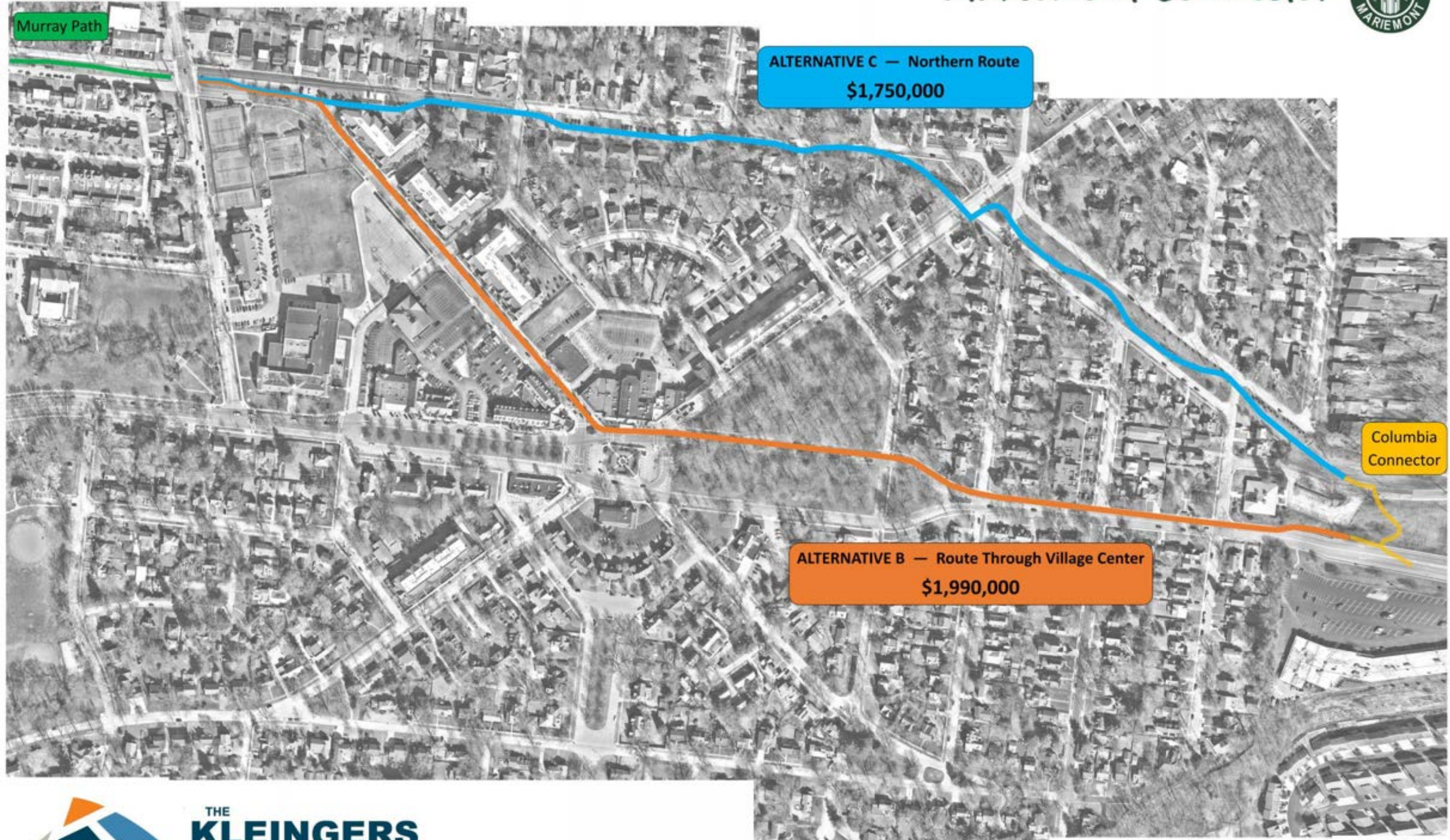
